FROM THE PASTOR

2 June 2019

As you know, the Auburn Catholic parishes along with the parish in Northern Cayuga have been in a pastoral planning process. This process was inaugurated with the knowledge that the current six priests assigned to this area would eventually be reduced to four. To plan for this eventuality, the parishes were divided into two clusters: each cluster eventually having one pastor and one parochial vicar.

Cluster 1 consists of St. Mary's, Ss Mary & Martha (St. Francis/St. Hyacinth), and Our Lady of the Snow (St. Joseph - Weedsport, St. John - Port Byron, St. Patrick - Cato). The current three priests in this cluster are Fr. Lioi, Fr. Miller and Fr. Darling.

Cluster 2 consists of St. Alphonsus, Holy Family, Sacred Heart and St. Ann. The current three priests in this cluster are Fr. Niven, Fr. Gathenya and Fr. Brown.

As of June 25, 2019, there will be one less priest for *Cluster 2* as Fr. Niven is being transferred from St. Alphonsus to St. Rita Parish in West Webster, outside of Rochester. With that in mind, the Bishop has assigned Fr. Gathenya as the pastor of all four parishes in Cluster 2, with Fr. Brown as the parochial vicar for all four parishes.

Cluster 1 at this time remains as is with the current three priests until a priest moves to senior priest status (retires), takes a new appointment, or is unable to continue.

The reality of all of this is that with the reduction of priests, there has to be a change in the weekend Mass schedule, so that two priests can take care of the parishes in their particular cluster. So beginning the weekend of June 29/30, *Cluster 2* will have a revised Mass Schedule, which is printed inside this bulletin.

The Mass schedule for *Cluster 1* remains as is, but most likely will be altered in the not-to-distant future to prepare for the eventuality of only two priests.

Auburn has been blessed in the past with an abundance of priests and a multitude of Masses. Even though there are fewer priests, a wide variety of Mass times that are still available.

Our first reading from the Acts of the Apostle has special significance to me. Stephen is the first Deacon and first Martyr of the Catholic Church. I connect with him at the diaconal level and hope not to have to connect so closely in the realm martyrdom. So far so good as the only one who may have wanted to kill me is my wife Cindy, and if so, for good cause. This past Thursday she and I celebrated our 10th Anniversary in the diaconate. I say "we" because as a married permanent deacon my response to this calling and the ministry assignments I am appointed to by the Bishop only happen if Cindy agrees in writing. To date, I have not had to forge her signature.

In all seriousness, the five years of preparing for ordination and ten years of ministry that have followed have brought us closer together in our marriage and I believe made us better parents, grandparents and friends in Christ to others. Much of that relates to the increasing obligation and importance of prayer and the added graces received from Mary through Jesus in His Spirit. We both look forward, God willing, to serve actively in diaconal ministry for the twelve years ahead in active status (age 75) and hopefully many more to follow in senior status. Our hope is that in those years other married couples and single men in the Auburn area will respond if called by God. If you feel so moved, most times through a soft movement of the heart, please reach out to Cindy and me for help discerning your movement forward in the call.

DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET will be prayed on this coming **First Friday, June 7th** at 3:00 pm at St. Hyacinth Church. The Chaplet is part of a Holy Hour consisting of exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, the singing of the chaplet, a period of quiet adoration, and concluding with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

Our Lord asked St. Faustina for special prayer and meditation of Jesus' Passion each day at the three o'clock hour, the hour that recalls His death on the cross. *"At three o'clock, implore My mercy, especially for sinners; and, if only for a brief moment, immerse yourself in My Passion, particularly in My abandonment at the moment of agony. This is the hour of great mercy"* (Diary 1320).

In this Sunday's gospel we see Jesus praying for his disciples and those who would come to believe in him down through the ages because of their sharing the gospel. Jesus prayed for His children, Us! WHAT'S IN YOUR HEART? Stephen's vision of Christ sitting at the right hand of God empowers him. How does your "vision" of who Jesus is inspire you? What is your "bright morning star"?

"I bring with me the recompense I will give to each according to his deeds," the Book of Revelation says. God calls you to offer an account of your stewardship of the life God has given you. Where have you done well? Where can you do more?

In the gospel Jesus offers the work he has done to his Father in heaven. And the glory of God comes down to bring glory to the earth. What are some ways you can offer your work to God, and so let God's glory into your life?
