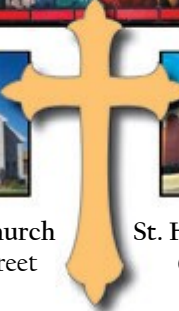

LITURGICAL THEMES & FEASTS:

Pentecost (June 4) kicks off our return to the summer months, followed by Trinity Sunday (June 11) and the Body and Blood of Christ (June 18)—the latter coinciding with Father's Day. These three comprise the "God feasts," honoring the Spirit in the church, the presence of Christ in our assembly, and Divine revelation in between.

This can seem a guy-heavy month, with 14 male saints' feasts and virtually no females. So make the most of BVM Saturdays to acknowledge what popes have called the feminine genius in the church. Also raise a shout-out for U.S. Saint Junipero Serra (July 1), still new enough to Catholics outside California to need some good press.

The secular world gives us more chances to quote from *Laudato Si'* on World Environment Day (June 5) and World Oceans Day (June 8). To encourage the common good, we also note World Blood Donor Day (coinciding with Flag Day— June 14) and World Day Against Drug Abuse and Trafficking (June 26).

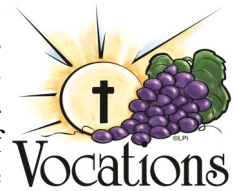

WEEKLY HOLY HOUR

is held at St. Francis Church on Thursdays at 5:30 pm. The Hour of Eucharistic Adoration consists of some quiet time, the praying in common of a portion of the Liturgy of the Hours, prayers for vocations to the priesthood and religious life, and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. We dedicate this one hour each week to prayers for vocations. Fr. Erick is the spiritual leader of this Eucharistic Hour of Adoration. Everyone is invited to come every week, some weeks or whenever you can.

FLY AWAY: Kindergarten was a half-day class, so I was already home when my third-grade brother came into the yard after school holding a big red helium balloon on a string that he had won. He saw the look on my face and carefully handed it to me so he could go inside and change out of his uniform and I could enjoy it for a while. He was a good guy. He warned me not to let go of the string. But the pull of the balloon in my hand to fly off was almost primordial. I started first by loosening my grip on the string and then retightening it. Then I opened my fist to let the string unravel before grabbing it back. Then I released the balloon completely and caught the string while it was still in my reach.

I took one too many chances. Just as my brother was coming out of the house to claim his balloon it flew out of my reach. We both just stood there and watched it go. Before I could apologize, my brother said, "Oh well; I guess that's what balloons are supposed to do." And then he went back into the house.

Pentecost reminds us that there are different gifts, but one Spirit. Just as a balloon has the ability to float away, we have the ability to be reconcilers and peacemakers. Pentecost invites us to let bygones be bygones and focus on the good things that await us in the life of the Spirit.

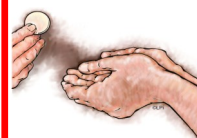
